Notary Public

The following Post members are commissioned as Notary Public's in the Commonwealth of Virginia:

- Bob Duvall
- Joseph G. Brady

They are authorized to legally notarize documents such as Power of Attorney, Bill of Sale, Will, Living Will, etc. Please check with the Post for an appointment.

Be aware that under VA code the notary must acknowledge:

- Signer must personally appear before the notary
- Signer is positively identified
- Signer must affirm under oath the accuracy of the document.

Acceptable Forms of Identification:

To be acceptable, the ID must be one of the following and current:

- Driver's license or State issued ID card
- U.S. Passport
- Foreign Passport (INS validated)
- Driver's license issued in Mexico or Canada
- U.S. Military ID Card.

We do not rely on Social Security cards or photo ID cards issued by non government entities. Under the law, the notary has the right to refuse, if he / she suspects anything may be false or wrong.

Scoutmasters have copies also. The first place winner from our Post will have their paperwork submitted to the next level of judging: The VFW Department (state) Chairman. Please make sure you read the instructions on the application and submit all the pertinent paperwork.

All scouting groups are wonderful programs. They encourage patriotism, leadership, duty to God and Country, duty to others and duty to self. They also offer friendship within their troops because they each belong to an elite group of boys and girls and their peers.

The last scholarship is The Young American Creative Patriotic Art Award. It is sponsored by the VFW Auxiliaries and is open to all students in grades 9-12. The deadline is March 31, 2018 to our Post. The instructions are specific on certain

items, such as flag presentations in the art, the types of art that cannot be entered (No digital art and no photographic art is accepted).

Please make sure that the instructions have been followed carefully and the explanation of Patriotism expressed artwork is attached. The application should be attached to the back of the artwork. One last item: be sure to follow correct flag etiquette when drawing the flag on your artwork. Contact Scholarship Chairman for applications.

Our Awards Ceremony for the Scholarship winners and Civil Servant winners will be held on Wednesday, April 11th at 7:00 pm at Post 392. All are welcome to attend. I especially hope the members who helped with the judging will attend this evening to see the fruits of their work from all the hours of judging.
